



COVID-19 PROTOCOL UPDATE AS OF SEPTEMBER 2022

COVID-19 Positive Cases:

- ▶ Positive cases are required to stay home for 6 days.
- ▶ After the 6 days: They may return upon feeling well, 24 hours without vomiting or diarrhea and fever-free for 24 hours without medication.
- ▶ Upon return, it is recommended that they wear a mask for 5 days.
- ▶ If a mask cannot be worn, it is recommended that they stay home until day 11.
- ▶ An email notification will be sent home regarding a positive case in the classroom.
- ▶ Walden Green's COVID-19 Liaison will notify the family of the return date and any details.
- ▶ **Reminder:** Please report any COVID-19 symptoms (two or more from the list below), any positive case, and household case to Walden Green's COVID-19 Liaison, Vickie.

Household Close Contact:

- ▶ It is recommended to wear a mask for 11 days.
- ▶ Monitor for symptoms for 11 days.
- ▶ It is recommended to test 3-7 days after exposure or if symptoms develop.
- ▶ If symptomatic, remain home or test for COVID-19 and provide test results.

COVID-19 Symptoms:

Headache, fever, chills, sore throat, cough, congestion, runny nose, shortness of breath, muscle aches, body aches, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue and loss of taste or smell. Symptoms can be mild to severe.

- ▶ Remain home if you are ill.
- ▶ Report if you have two or more symptoms, from the list above, to Walden Green's COVID-19 Liaison.
- ▶ It is recommended that you test for COVID-19 and provide the results.
- ▶ If positive for COVID-19, see above for protocols.

There will be no contact tracing or notification of close contacts.

There is no longer the requirement for COVID-19 positive cases to be posted on the Walden Green website.
